2020 Report Back to the Community



Dear Friends of the Scioto Foundation,

2020 marked an interesting year that presented unprecedented challenges for all businesses and individuals. However, our staff was able to provide another record-breaking year to the communities we serve. By the end of 2020, our total assets had grown to a new high of \$49 million. This financial success allowed us to award 622 grants to local nonprofits and 436 scholarships of \$533,666 for a total of \$1.46 million.

Our signature programs, Rethinking Downtown Portsmouth, Scioto 365, Scioto Gives and University/College Access Network (UCAN) had an equally successful year as well. Main Street Portsmouth, in partnership with the City of Portsmouth and the Portsmouth Chamber of Commerce, was awarded the 2nd Rethinking Downtown Portsmouth Grant in the amount of \$60,000 for outdoor exercise equipment to be placed at York Park along the riverfront. The Scioto 365 members voted to award the Steven A. Hunter Hope Fund \$10,000 for its Power Pack program to provide weekend food to those who are deemed food insecure. During Scioto Gives, donors such as yourself helped to raise \$117,588 for 40 local nonprofits. Within that 12-hour giving period, Scioto Foundation also matched every eligible donation \$0.43 on the dollar bringing the total amount raised to \$167,588. The most amazing report of our signature programs belongs to UCAN. The 17 school districts in Scioto County and its surrounding areas now have a combined scholarship fund total of \$2.6 million. The Scioto Foundation's UCAN General Fund has reached \$440,000. It is anticipated that the school scholarships will award over \$106,000 in scholarships for the 2020-2021 school year.

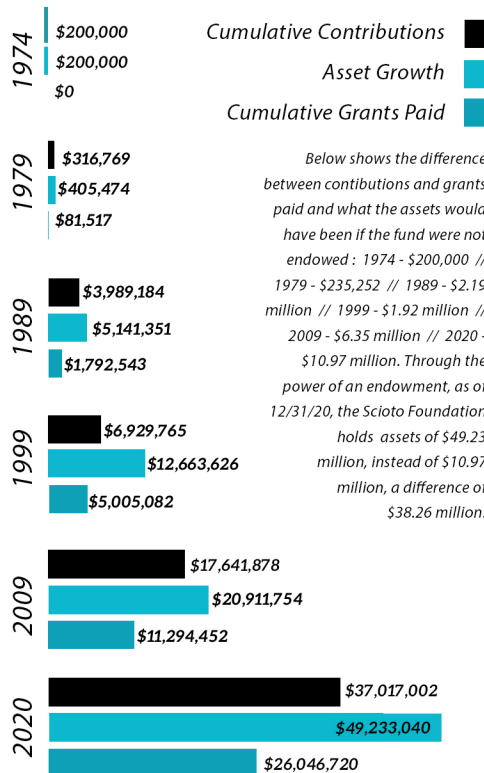
It is also a great pleasure to mention our partnership with the City of Portsmouth which, under the direction of the planning group MKSK, helped to create the Portsmouth City Master Plan Elevate Portsmouth. We hope this will inspire the community to create future opportunities in the downtown area. To kick start this plan, we will offer \$50,000 through our Rethinking Downtown Portsmouth grant initiative to organizations fulfilling projects within the Master Plan parameters.

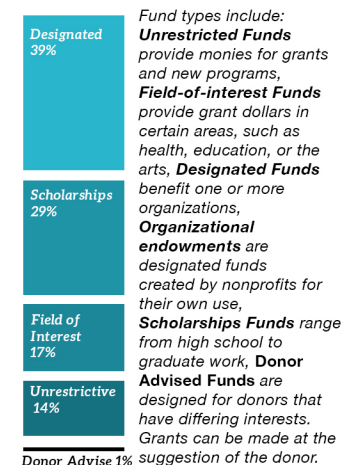


Vital Statistics

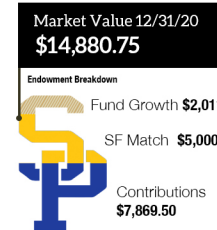


Why are endowments so important for our students? A good example of why endowments are so important for our students is the Clay Schools Legacy Scholarship Fund has grown by \$114,338.11 while paying out \$83,500 in scholarships. If this fund wasn't endowed and part of the UCAN program, only a total \$26,488 would be available for scholarships. However, since this fund is endowed, \$13,994 is available for the 2021-22 school year while maintaining the current market value, of \$349,863, enabling the school to provide scholarships at that level for years to come.

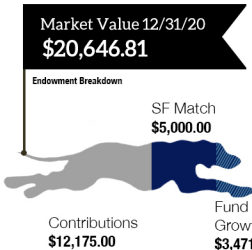
